



## VILLAGE OF LIPTON

### BYLAW NO. 10-2023

#### A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF LIPTON RESPECTING THE PRESERVATION OF ORDER


The Council of the Village of Lipton in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. It shall be unlawful for any person to be found drunk or fighting or offering to fight or quarreling or brawling or shouting or otherwise disorderly in any public street or place in the Village of Lipton.
2. a. No person shall make use of any profane, obscene, blasphemous or grossly insulting language, or be guilty of any immorality or indecency in any street or public place in the Village of Lipton.  
b. Except by consent of Council no person shall, either himself or through another person, put, place or leave any animal, vehicle, snow, building material, firewood, goods, wares, glass bottles, merchandise or thing of any kind whatsoever upon, or in any way directly or indirectly encumber, obstruct, injure or foul any street, lane, square, walk, sidewalk, road, bridge, ditch, gutter, drain or sewer.
3. No person shall ring any bell, except for church and school bells, blow any horn, beat any drum, shout or make any noise calculated to disturb or annoy the inhabitants or by manner of conduct commit any public nuisance by collecting, loitering or standing as idlers on any street or sidewalk of the said town, or on the step of or approach to a house or other premises where the public are liable to be subjected to disturbance or annoyance; provided always that nothing contained in this section shall be construed to extend to any procession or service not contrary to law. 4. a) In this section a firearm shall mean any gun, air gun, pellet gun, rifle, shotgun, catapult, or fowling piece.  
b) Subject to subsection 4(e) hereof no person shall discharge any firearm of any description in any street lane or other place within the Village of Lipton.  
c) Subject to subsection 4(e) hereof no person shall transport or carry a loaded firearm within the Village of Lipton.  
d) Subject to subsection 4(e) hereof no person shall transport or carry a firearm within the Village of Lipton unless it is in a proper case.  
e) The Royal Canadian Mounted Police and any Predator Control Officer(s) appointed by resolution of Lipton Village Council may transport, carry and discharge firearms in the Village of Lipton as required in the lawful carrying out of their duties.  
f) Further referenced in Bylaw 01-2021 A Bylaw of the Village of Lipton to Provide for the Control and Regulation of Firearms in the Village of Lipton.
5. a) In this section the word fireworks means firecrackers, rocket, squib, or any other object or substance designed to be exploded or burned to produce noises or brilliant lighting effects.



- b) Subject to subsection 5(e) hereof, no person shall set off, detonate, ignite or cause to be exploded any fireworks in this town.
- c) i) The Council may authorize the Town Administrator to issue to any person or persons a permit, in writing, authorizing the setting off in the town or in any part or parts of the town, as may be specified in the permit, of fireworks or any class thereof as may be specified in the permit, the duration of which permit may be specified therein.
  - ii) A permit issued under clause (1) of this section shall prescribe the conditions under which a display of fireworks or any specified class or classes thereof may be held in the town or in any specified part or parts of the town and no person shall conduct a display of fireworks in contravention of such prescribed conditions.
- 6. Any person convicted of any breach of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine as outline in Bylaw 2018-17 General Penalty Bylaw.
- 7. This Bylaw shall come into force and effect immediately upon the final passing thereof.
