Garbage Pick up etiquette/rules

Garbage pick up:

1. **DO NOT** leave water in the bottom of the cans/rotting;
2. **DO NOT** put Loose dog droppings/cat litter;
3. Bag all garbage;
4. Trees - if it is not neatly stacked and easy for pick up we will not grab them. Trees to be picked up should be placed in the backalley in a location that does not block the alley;
5. We will not pick up random garbage all over a residents yard. It needs to be in the proper pick up area.
6. Do not leave broken bottles in the bottom of the bins.
7. Composte is only composte. Do not put garbage, diapers, dog droppings, plastic containers, plastic bags, hopes or dreams in with the compost.
8. Composte dumped in alleys will not be picked up. Please bag it.
9. The tree pile on the lagoon road is just for trees. Do not place pallets or lumber in the tree pile.
10. Garbage bags should not be over 25 Lbs Max.

Thank you in advance for ensuring the garbage is ready for us to pick up.

SaskPower has contracted a company to trim trees by power lines. Please stay out of their way and allow them to do what they need to do.




WALKING AT NIGHT

- Dandelions are out in full force. Make sure you keep them under control before they go to seed. We will try to do the same.




North Valley Waste Management

There is a new sign placed to indicated what can and cannot go into those bins. Please read the sign and adhere to the rules.

The Recycle bins are for Lipton residents ONLY!



R.M. of Lipton residents: Please be advised the R.M. of Lipton No. 217 had implemented a fire ban on May 8th, 2021 and it is still in effect. Before starting a fire/burning in the RM please call 1-866-404-4911 to find out if it is still active and to register any controlled burns – even when the ban is lifted call in all controlled burns, including garbage.

- Beaver Tails will be in Lipton on June 9th; we have already had Booster Juice and are looking for other ideas for treats for the summer so if you have any contacts or suggestions please stop by the office or email lipton@sasktel.net.
- Dogs and cats are to be on leashes or contained within your own yard when outside. No exceptions. Do not allow them to roam free and do their business in other people's yards.
- When walking your dog be sure to pick up anything they drop – do not leave it behind.
- Permits are required for most building projects. If you are unsure what is needed feel free to contact the office and we will help you out.




