BYLAW #2018-03

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR A CURFEW

The Council of the Village of Lipton, of the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. No children under the age of Twelve (12) years shall be on the streets of the Village after the hour of 10:00 p.m. Nothing herein contained shall apply to a child who is accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- 2. Any parent or guardian found guilty of permitting a child to contravene the provisions of this bylaw, after being warned in writing by the Administrator, shall be liable to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Village.
- 3. Bylaw No. 6, 1992 is hereby repealed.
