

Fun Facts About School!

World's Largest School: The City Montessori School in Lucknow, India, holds the Guinness World Record for being the largest school in the world, with over 55,000 students enrolled.

Oldest School: Shishi High School in Chengdu, China, is recognized as the world's oldest school, established in 194 AD. It has modernized over the years while maintaining its historical significance.

Recycled Schools: In the Philippines, there is a school made of recycled pop bottles, known as the Bottle School. It took about 9,000 bottles to construct it.

Cultural Practices: In Japan, students participate in a cleaning tradition called o soji, where they clean their classrooms at the end of each school day. This practice is believed to promote teamwork and respect for the environment.

Giant Cardboard Cones: In Germany, children receive a Schultüte, a giant cardboard cone filled with candy and school supplies, on their first day. This tradition marks the beginning of their educational journey.

Take care of your sewer lines!

There are things you can do as a resident to help keep your sewer lines in good shape:

- Don't dump grease or food down sink drains.
- Don't flush sanitary products or wipes of any kind down the toilet. Even the flushable kind cause problems!
- Keep water flowing! Water going down the lines is an important part of keeping them functioning properly – the running water helps prevent buildup and blockages.
- Take action sooner rather than later if you're noticing slow drainage anywhere.


