Water Rate Increase

The Village of Lipton and the Saskatchewan Municipal Board have approved a rate increase of \$1.00 for water and \$1.00 for sewer for 2026. An increase of \$1.00 for WATER ONLY for 2027 has been approved Below is a portion of Schedule A from Bylaw 07-2025 Sewer and Water Bylaw.

Bulk water rates are increasing by \$1.00 in 2026 and 2027.

1. Monthly Water Rates for users within the Village of Lipton limits:

3,000 gallons or less

Minimum \$51.00 for 2026

Minimum \$52.00 for 2027

and \$12.00 for each additional 1,000 gallons thereafter.

Monthly Water Rates for users outside the Village of Lipton limits:
 3,000 gallons or less
 Minimum \$72.35 for 2026
 Minimum \$73.35 for 2027

and \$13.00 for each additional 1,000 gallons thereafter.

3. Monthly Infrastructure Fee (Water and Sewer upgrades)

Monthly fee: Minimum \$25.00

4. Coin operated and Key FOB metered tank fill rate:
\$31.00 for 1,000 gallons for 2026
\$32.00 for 1,000 gallons for 2027
Key FOB refundable deposit is \$30.00/FOB


