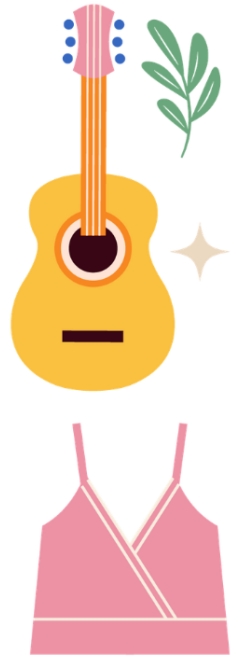

Did you know?

The nice weather has finally arrived!

Now that pets can be outdoors for longer periods, please be mindful of the bylaws, and of other residents enjoying the outdoors.

Please clean up after your pets, both on your own property and around the Village if you are out for a walk. Do not let animals run at large. Pets should be kept on your own property, and dogs should be leashed at all times when being walked.



We do not recommend feeding strays. This encourages them to stay within town limits, and could even be someone's pet that wandered off.

Lipton Fire Department

Fire Pit Safety

Placement:

Place your fire pit away from buildings, trees, fences, and other flammable structures, avoid overhanging branches and clear dry grass. Place your fire pit on a non-combustible, flat.

Weather Considerations:

Avoid using a fire pit on windy days, as sparks can ignite nearby structures or vegetation.

Fuel and Management:

Burn dry, seasoned hardwoods like oak or hickory and avoid softwoods, treated wood, or construction lumber. Never use accelerants to start a fire. Once started, never leave a fire unattended and keep children and pets at a safe distance. Use long-handled tools to manage the fire, keeping hands and clothing away from flames.

Safety Equipment:

Before lighting, inspect your fire pit for damage, clean ash or debris after each use, and check gas connections for leaks if using a gas fire pit. Keep a fire extinguisher, bucket of water, or sand nearby, and know how to use them.

Always make sure you are in compliance with local bylaws and provincial bans.

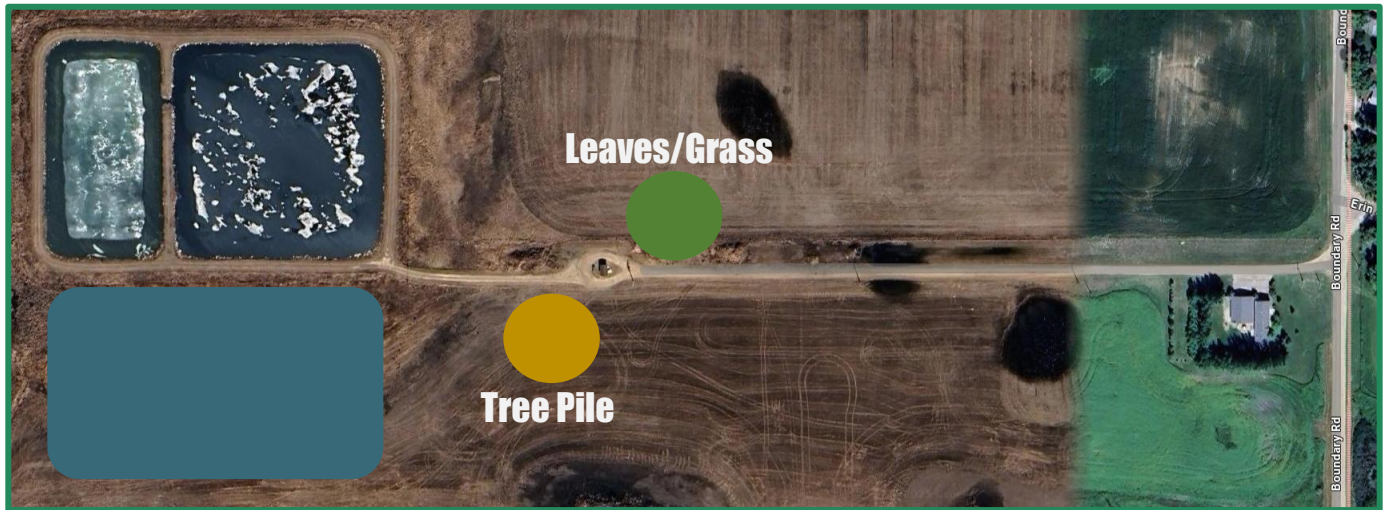

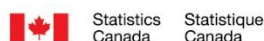
Important to know:
