

**Fire Safety Tips**

Batteries like the ones in your cell phone can overheat, catch fire or explode if they aren't used properly. Make sure you are charging devices on a hard surface, and use the chargers that came with the devices.

In winter make sure you are checking the vents around the outside of your home and keeping them clear of ice and snow. This can include your dryer, stove, furnace or fireplace. Keeping them clear ensures that you will not have a buildup of carbon monoxide in your home.

When using space heaters, only plug one into each outlet to avoid starting fires. It is also important to ensure you are not plugging any heating appliances into extension cords.

## Rec Centre


