PUBLIC NOTICE - VILLAGE OF LIPTON

Notice of Intent to adopt the Bylaw No. 01-2024 known as the "Village of Lipton Official Community Plan" and Bylaw No. 02-2024 known as the "Village of Lipton Zoning Bylaw".

NOTICE:

The Council of the Village of Lipton hereby gives notice of its intention to adopt an Official Community Plan and Zoning Bylaw pursuant to *The Planning and Development Act, 2007*.

REASON:

The **Official Community Plan (OCP)** will help direct and manage growth and development in the Village of Lipton for 15-20 years. This document defines, directs, evaluates, and guides the Council in making development and land-use decisions. The objectives and policies address the future requirements and directions for growth of residential, commercial, industrial, recreational, and municipal land-uses.

The **Zoning Bylaw** is a regulatory document that implements the policies contained in the OCP. This document will divide the Village of Lipton into five (5) zoning districts based on existing and intended future land-uses. The Zoning Bylaw contains regulations and standards including the size, setbacks, and location of lots and buildings, off-street parking, and landscaping, etc. Each district will contain its own list of permitted uses and discretionary uses, along with general regulations that apply to development in all districts.

AFFECTED LAND:

The proposed OCP and Zoning Bylaw encompass all properties within the Municipality of the Village of Lipton.

PUBLIC INSPECTION:

The document and maps of the OCP and Zoning Bylaw may be viewed at the Village of Lipton office located at 210 Main Street Lipton SK. These documents may be examined by any person without payment of any fee on Monday through Friday between the hours of 9:00 am – 4:00 pm, excluding holidays, up to March 28, 2024 (date of public hearing).

Digital copies of the bylaw documents are available at request to lipton@villageoflipton.com and hard copies may be obtained from the village office at a cost of \$25.00. REPRESENTATIONS:

The Municipality is open in accepting any written representations from the public that states their concerns or comments regarding the proposed Bylaw No. 01-2024 and Bylaw No. 02-2024. Written representations or any other forms with your full name and civic address shall be submitted no later than March 21, 2024, to the village office or email to lipton@villageoflipton.com.

PUBLIC HEARING:

The Council will hear all submissions respecting the proposed OCP and Zoning Bylaw on:

March 28, 2024, that is at least 28 days from newspaper publication at 7:00 pm in the Lipton Community Hall.

Council will hear all persons who are present at the meeting and wish to speak on this matter. They will also consider written comments received at the hearing or delivered to the undersigned before the hearing.





2. Create an online shopping account, or log into your existing shopping account.
3. **All orders will be fulfilled by Prairie Co-op @ Fort Qu'Appelle Food Store.** Select Pickup to find the Fort Qu'Appelle Food Store on the list.
4. Scroll down the list, or enter your address to find **Prairie Co-op @ Fort Qu'Appelle Food Store** in the list. Choose this store. *This is only to choose the Food Store that will be fulfilling the order; NOT the actual pickup location.*
5. Start shopping! Add your items to your virtual grocery cart.



6. **If you want to take advantage of the free grocery delivery service to Lipton, you must add the line "Deliver to Lipton Store" in the comments/special instructions section at checkout.** There is no charge for this service!
7. **Orders must be placed through WWW.SHOP.CRS on Thursday morning to ensure current flyer pricing and same day delivery to Prairie Co-op in Lipton.** Groceries will arrive by 4pm on Thursdays.
