## Take care of sewer lines!

Did you know that using toilet paper that is very thick ply will not break down well, and will put you at risk of clogged sewer drains?

Sanitary products, baby wipes and "flushable" wipes also cause blockages and should not be flushed.

Not having enough water flow (low flow toilets, low usage) also puts you at risk.

Taking care of sewer lines now can prevent costly problems later!




The locations for disposing of trees/branches and grass/leaves are marked out on the map below. Please be sure you are dumping these items in the appropriate locations.



### Lipton Volunteer Fire Dept.



Did you know that firefighting equipment undergoes testing too?

The blue pool of water is called a Portapond. It holds 2000 gallons. They pull the water out of the portapond and blast it back in through a measuring device to make sure the pump has the correct output of gallons per minute and the correct engine RPM. This ensures that the fire truck meets the standards set by the National Fire Prevention Association. This test is performed annually.

A portapond is a portable holding area for water at fire scenes. It can help ensure there is adequate water supply at a fire event, and can be transported on fire trucks to an incident location.
